“Why/How should Christians educate their children?”

Disciples are students or followers of Christ. Therefore, if we are disciples of Christ, we should be good stewards and teach and train our children to be “Students Of the Word” & to “abide in Christ”. The SOW Curriculum or SOW Devotional will help disciple you, as well as, your students, making it the perfect tool to follow in Jesus’ foot steps. As Christians, are we going to be able to say this concerning our children...“I have glorified You, Father, by accomplishing the task you have sent Me to do....Those You have given Me,... have received Your Word... make them one as We are one.” Jesus

Unique Characteristics of the SOW Curriculum* ...

1. Biblical vision... The goal is to know God; the method is discipleship; the main text is the Bible.

2. Comprehensive education... There are lessons for all the major K-12th subjects such as Bible, prayer, penmanship/memory, creative writing, literature, English, spelling, speech, reading, foreign language (Hebrew & Greek), science, geography, history, plus various electives; Math is not included.

3. Accredited and free resources ... The recommended resources meet national standards for grades K-12th using texts such as Bob Jones, ABeka, Rod & Staff, IEW, AIG, etc.. Note: Each subject/ lesson has free online links.

4. Integrated subjects ... Every subject is centered on the Bible (not history, literature, principle, or doctrine) creating a special connection between all the subjects.

5. Discipleship approach... Each student is taught how to Praise- Repent-Ask- Yield, study the Bible inductively from Genesis to Revelation, memorize the Scriptures, walk in the Spirit, and a Biblical view in every subject.

6. Individually paced... This is achieved through personal schedules, step by step lessons, one on one instruction, and various skill level worksheets and charts.

7. Nondenominational ... Utilizing parental guidance, inductive skills, critical thinking, various sources, the Bible (any version) as the main text, assures a nonbiased Biblical Christian education.

8. Multi-level instruction ... Whole concepts & skills transcend grades, abilities, or ages.

9. Mastery of whole concepts & various skills... All major K-12th subject/topics, except math, are learned by repeating skills, such as outline, vocabulary, topical, character, setting, application, survey, biography, poetry, letter, comparison, persuasion, demonstration, explanation, drama, art, craft, music, service, model, nature, journal, timeline, map, culture/resource study, report, experiment, observation, and/or diagram, until all subject concepts and skills are mastered.

10. All students inclusive... K-12th, special needs, and/or English second language students learn by skill & concept repetition, step by step lessons, & utilizing oral, drawing, &/or writing to communicate.

11. Friendly Budget... There is no need to purchase multiple texts for each grade level per subject for each student (12 years x 10 subjects = at least 120

texts to purchase). The SOW has free links per lesson and recommended accredited texts are used as multiple grade level sources.

12. Biblical view... Wisdom is achieved, not just acquired knowledge because the Bible is the main text & inductive skills are used to seek the truth in every subject.

13. Testing & evaluating... Diagnostic and/or achievement tests, student progress reports, personal check outs, & subject evaluations of completed lessons keep the parent, teacher, & officials informed of the student's progress

14. Personal & home management ... Instructions, schedules, & charts train the student to be good stewards of their time and responsibilities.

Unique Characteristics of the SOW Devotional ...**

1. The SOW Devotional is a unique Biblical plan to know God & make disciples (students) of Christ; the Bible is the main text. It includes 5 P-R-A-Y-S letters, 8 Bible inductive (to draw out the truth) study methods, & 5 Scripture memory activities; a scope & sequence with 144 lessons from Genesis to Revelations; and 7 reproducible skill level (SL) worksheets for Beginner (K-5th SL) and Intermediate (6th-college SL), a suggested weekly schedule, and a recommended resource list (hard text & free online links).

2. The SOW Devotional is designed for all ages (kindergarten through college and special needs skill abilities). It is to be used by individuals, couples, families, schools (public, private, home, charter, missionary), churches, classes, or groups.

3. The SOW Devotional can be used anytime, but it is best to devote a certain time each day.

4. The SOW Devotional should be used at a special place, quiet and free of distractions, but it can be any place...home, church, school, park, jail, hospital, or other.

5. The SOW Devotional will teach each student how to daily pray by writing love letters to God, study the Bible from Genesis to Revelations, and memorize KSV (key Scripture verses).

6. The SOW Devotional's goal is for every person at any age to devote consistent & quality time with God, their Creator, in prayer, and meditating & memorizing His Word to intimately know & walk with Him in all life's circumstances.
